文学院现有教职工135人,其中专任教师115人,正高职称43人, 各类高层次人才30人次,博士后研究人员23人,来自美国、德国、土 耳其、印度、秘鲁等国家和地区的全职外籍教师9人。

文学院名誉院长为著名作家叶辛,拥有董乃斌、谢维扬、王晓明、 陶飞亚、郭长刚等一批知名学者。

文学院以"博文雅人、转识成智、守文持正、求变求新"为发展 理念,培养文史兼修、中西会通、知行合一,具有国际视野的研究 型、创新性人才。

目前文学院在校学生1200余人,其中本科生430余人,硕士研 究生、博士研究生800余人(其中包括国际留学生130余人)。

文学院不断完善课程设置,加强核心通识课和精品课程建设 成立了本科生教学指导委员会,提升教育教学质量。改革研究生招 生制度,2018年起,博士研究生开始实行"申请一审核"制。

HISTORY

Founding History:

In December 1978, College of Liberal Arts, formerly as a division of Fudan University was founded.

Development:

In June 1983, the division of Fudan University was officially renamed College of Liberal Arts, Shanghai University (CLA, SHU) and was incorporated into Shanghai University established at that time.

In May 1994, four universities were merged to form the new Shanghai University, and College of Liberal Arts (CLA) at that time has nine departments including Sociology, Chinese Language and Literature, History, Economy, Film, Advertisement, Administration, Information and Archives.

In July 2011, CLA became an official liberal arts college composed of 3 departments including Chinese Language and Literature, History, and Cultural Studies after disciplinary restructuring and adjustment.





CONSTRUCTION

CLA has three departments of Chinese Language and Literature, History, and Cultural Studies with a complete disciplinary system. In 2015, three first-class disciplines of Chinese Language and Literature, Chinese History and World History were selected as "Plateau Disciplines" by Shanghai Municipal Education Commission.

With the motto of "Accumulate knowledge and cultivate elegance; turn intelligence into wisdom; stay righteous and truthful; seek reformation and innovation", CLA aims to provide society with talents cultivated in literature and history, Chinese and western culture, global vision, innovative spirit and practical know-how.

At present, CLA has about 1200 students: 430 undergraduates and 800 postgraduates including 130 international students.

CLA makes great effort to improve its quality of education through deepening teaching reform, building teams of faculty and improving the curriculum, with measures such as establishing Steering Committee of Undergraduate Teaching, reforming postgraduates and doctoral students enrollment system and developing core general education courses and high-level courses; some of those include Becoming a Writer, LU Xun and Contemporary China, Introduction to Literature of Tang and Song Dynasties, Literature Classics and Modern Life, Archaeology and Ancient China, Theories and Approaches of American History Studies, Value Cognition & Protection and Utilization of Cultural Heritage from Contemporary Perspective: Focus on the Forbidden City, An Introduction to Dunhuang Studies, Chinese Folk Culture Studies, Chinese Sign Language and Introduction to Chinese linguistics.



Since 2015, about 30% of graduates and postgraduates have been admitted to graduate schools at home and abroad each year; about 20 postgraduate students are funded by China Scholarship Council to do exchange studies in prestigious universities such as University of California, Irvine, University of Alberta, University College Cork, University of Buenos Aires, Koc University. Since 2017, about 28% of the students have had the opportunity to partake in short-term study programs abroad.

CLA has built a range of curricular and ex-curricular training platforms such as the tutor system, Qisi College, "The Night of Literature", "310: Dates with Shanghai Culture," which not only contribute to students' learning, but play a positive role in romoting liberal arts education and improving the humanities environment at Shang-






Since 2012, the faculty have published more than 100 papers in high-level academic journals, such as Social Science in China, Literary Review, Historical Research, Studies of the Chinese Language, and also in top journals included in SSCI or A&HCI. There are around 100 research projects that have been approved and funded.

2 research projects were selected as National Social Science Achievement Database; 3 as outstanding achievements by the Ministry of Education; 31 as outstanding achievements at provincial or ministerial levels; 18 reports have been adopted or approved by relevant departments at provincial, ministerial or higher levels.

CLA has 36 research centers or research bases, which serve as powerful platforms for disciplinary development, talent cultivation and international exchange and collaboration.

o promote the internationalization of learning, CLA takes a lead in employng full-time international faculty, assisting the Chinese faculty to do research in overseas universities, helping students to do exchange studies overseas with funding from China Scholarship Council, Wellcome Trust, etc., and attracting nternational students from diversified backgrounds, and building internationl research centers.

CLA has established long-term collaboration with nearly 40 universities or institutions around the world, including University of Strathclyde, Ghent University, University of California, Santa Cruz, Waseda University, Hankuk University of Foreign Studies, University of Western Australia and the CEIL of CONICET in Argentina.

In 2018, the number of international conferences organized by CLA reached over 20, including some high-end international conferences, such as "World Archeology Forum", "The 12th International Crossroads in Cultural Studies Biennial" and "International Conference on China-Latin America Community

There are more than 130 international students currently studying at CLA, and there are 3 English degree programs, i.e. Chinese Studies, International Relations and Diplomacy, International Organizations and Governance. CLA is making efforts to start an international humanities experimental class for students specializing in international organizations, international politics, and international relations, and to create an integrated education of Chinese and international students.

CLA always takes talent cultivation as its core mission, insists on connotative and open development, strives to build a first-class research-oriented college and cultivates high quality talents.
